Tribute to Toney Edwards November 25, 2019

Toney Edwards Vice-President Compagnons du Beaujolais, Devoir de NY 1944-2018

William Toney Edwards, 74, restaurateur, designer, and yachtsman, died November 10, 2018 of pancreatic cancer in Stuart, Florida. The son of Mae Sue Thompson and William Van Buren Edwards, Jr. he was born in Amarillo, Texas, and grew up in Wichita Falls. He attended UT and <u>Yale University</u> where he trained in technical theater and design. Toney worked in theaters in Rochester, Minnesota, and Atlanta. He opened Las Amis Cafe in Austin in 1970, and is best known as proprietor of Le Madeleine in New York City from 1979 to 2008. He will be greatly missed by his family and friends.

Toney was part of the first group of Maitres Compagnons who dedicated their time and efforts to the promotion of the wines of Beaujolais through highlighting the great work done by local vignerons. He participated in the first trip to the region in the mid 90's as part of the Best Beaujolais Bistro Cup as the owner of Le Madeleine. On September 12, 2001, he hosted a planned Beaujolais tasting at his famed restaurant, just to show terrorists that he was not impressed. He signed up as the Vice-President of the Compagnons du Beaujolais, Devoir de NY at its inception in September 2002 and barely missed a chapter until last year. He had moved to Florida earlier in 2018, leaving us somewhat orphaned. He wanted to start anew, but life took a different turn for him.

We will never drink a glass of Beaujolais without thinking about him, his generosity, his kindness, his smarts and his positive outlook on life.
